On Sunday, January 16, 2022, the 16<sup>th</sup> French March for Life will take place in Paris. It gathers thousands of marchers who reaffirm their unconditional commitment to respect life, from its conception to its natural death.

We have to cope with many threats such as projects to extend the legal time limit for abortion. Our country is recording a significant drop in the birth rate to 1.84. It cannot be denied that there is a correlation between the thousands of abortions carried out each year in France - 222,000 in 2020 - and the drastic fall in the birth rate.

In addition, in this upcoming presidential election year, the debate on assisted suicide and euthanasia is likely to be the next societal topic.

In this context the Paris March for Life, aspires to rebuilt society on the respect of all human life, and calls on the French people to stand for life.

For all these reasons, knowing your interest in this just cause, we would be happy and honoured by your presence on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> January in Paris. The demonstration will start at 1.30 pm at Place de Catalogne, and will end with speeches at Place Vauban.
